

The Winslow Township Park District Board met on Saturday, March 25, 2006 at the maintenance building at 7:30 a.m. Those present were: Fred, Dee, Angie, Dave, Darla, and Barb, Lawrence Janike came for a brief time.

Barbara read the minutes Dee had prepared from the February meeting. Dee approved the minutes. Dave seconded them and they were approved as read.

The Treasurer's report was handed to each one present. The total of \$760.00 was needed to pay bills for the month. The lawn mower had the hood and wraparound replaced to the sides. Dee moved we accept the Treasurer's report. Angie seconded the motion and it was approved.

Dee reported about the Easter Egg Hunt plans. It will be held on April 15th at 10:00 a.m. Games will be held on the tennis court similar to those held at the Halloween Party. (Spin the wheel, gift bag of candy, eat marshmallow peep contest, pin the tail on the bunny, bullseye on the bunny, and the duck pond.) Games will be available before and after the egg hunt. David will provide a plastic pool. All Board members are requested to come to help out on the 15th. A real egg toss will be held for adults; three dozen eggs will be purchased. Gift baskets will be available for 1 child per each group. Dave moved that up to \$500.00 be spent on the party. Fred seconded and it was approved.

Signs are completed. Angie picked them up. Darla is sending WTPD park information to Connie Sorn at the Stephenson County Information Bureau website.

Barb will get 3 groups to entertain at the Park in the summer on the second or third Friday night in June, July, and August. We need more advertising done for a better crowd.

Lawrence Janike is willing to do odd jobs. We will give him a key. He will work on the aluminum planks for the bleachers, take out the garbage on Sunday nights, weed-eat and work on the ceiling in the pit area. Angie moved to give all the hours Lawrence Janike needs for work. Dee seconded the motion and it was approved. Gerald Wire will do the mowing this summer.

Garbage pickup begins April 17th and will end November 6th. Darla wants a whole year billing. The water will be turned on by April 15th.

The Board discussed the bond for the Treasurer, Darla Cobb. We agreed we would not have insurance coverage on our Treasurer.

We will NOT put money into the old projector.

Angie will take pictures of the serial numbers. We will renew IPARKS (Board members are covered by insurance).

Dave gave information about basketball hoops. Dee moved we pay \$750.00 each for movable poles totaling about \$2500.00 Angie seconded the motion and it was approved. July 9th, the park is needed by the Watson's for a reunion, August 6th, Raisbeck reunion, and September a wedding. Next meeting: April 15th before the hunt.
