

Village of Winslow Village Board Meeting

The Winslow Village Board met in regular session on Wednesday, April 11, 2007 , at 7:02 PM. at the Village Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mr.Croup. The roll call went as follows:

A motion was made by Mr. Diffenderfer and seconded by Mrs, McPhillips to approve the minutes of the last meeting. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mrs. McPhillips and seconded by Mr. Hastings to approve the financial report. All were in favor. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Mr. Nesemeier had radar gun inspected.

STREETS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES AND SIDEWALKS:

PUBLIC PROPERTY, WATER AND SEWER:

A request was made by zoning board of review regarding 220 Carver Street to make it a residence rather than business. Spot zoning is done in Lena as necessary. Mrs. McPhillips made a motion and Mr. Diffenderfer seconded to rezone the address of 220 Carver Street to residence. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Bullseye Portable Restrooms would like to be our source again for pumping the portable restrooms. Mr. Croup will contact them to find prices, etc.

Situation at pump house was taken care of. The fire department pumped and it started working.

Mr. Mason and Mr. Croup have been checking to see where they can go to get new samples done. We are not required to send samples to the state now. They have found one in Stockton area and will pick up the samples.

They are replacing fire hydrants. They are trying to let people know ahead of time when this happens because it goes from 9:00 to 3:00 PM. There's one hydrant by Broge's that should be a little higher. Someone will check into it.

HEALTH, WELFARE AND POLICE:

Mr. Diffenderfer stated that there are nuisance properties that need to be taken care of. Mr. Nesemeier is checking them.

FINANCE AND APPROPRIATIONS:

Nothing at this time.

PERMITS AND LICENSE:

Mr. Marks has gone for Pesitcide training. He will be staying at a hotel for 2 nights and wants to be reimbursed as soon as possible. Mr. Hastings made a motion and it was seconded by Mrs. McPhillips to cut a check for \$350.00 to cover motel and use whatever is left over for meals and gas.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Mr. Croup met with Com Ed today. With the restructuring, every pump has its own account number and bills. There are some pumps that run 24 hours a day and Mr. Croup has not seen any bill yet. When we get a bill it will be horrendous. The only relief that Com Ed can offer will be the same amount of time to pay the bill as it took Com Ed to get the bill to us. Mr. Croup only brought this up so that the board would not be surprised when the bill finally comes through.

A motion was made by Mrs. McPhillips and seconded by Mr. Hastings to approve the bills with the addition of \$350 for Mr. Marks. Roll call was made. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mr. Croup adjourned the meeting at 9:55 PM.
