

Village of Winslow Village Board Meeting

The Winslow Village Board met in regular session on Wednesday, November 8, 2006, at 7:00 PM. at the Village Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Croup. The roll call went as follows:

A motion was made by Mrs. McPhillips and seconded by Mr. Diffenderfer to approve the minutes of the last meeting. All were in favor. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Chad Temple and Patti are looking at an after school program for the kids in the neighborhood. There are quite a few children who have a handicap. They are thinking about getting a virtual library here. They are looking at grants and buildings, etc. to see what can be done.

STREETS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES AND SIDEWALKS:

PUBLIC PROPERTY, WATER AND SEWER:

Mr. Mason mentioned that we got the water leak fixed today. He also got sampling done yesterday. The results were both good. A list is also being drawn on where the shut off valves are. We also really need to look at cleaning the water tower.

Fehr Graham has sent the grant funding project out for bids. According to the drawings, the main on Hubbard all the way to 73 along with the hydrants would be replaced. It does not say anything about the curb stops for the rest of the town. A clarification has to be made as to what they plan on doing for the remainder of Winslow. Someone will contact Fehr Graham for clarification.

Mr. Diffenderfer stated that if we get new hydrants, the water department should be flushing the hydrants. They test the pressure, etc while it is being done and if there are any problems, they should notify the fire department immediately.

HEALTH, WELFARE AND POLICE:

Mr. Nesemeier is excited about the new police car that has Winslow actually on the car. He would like to take the squad car down to Lena when they have a parade for the Panthers should they continue winning.

Changing out the equipment for the car was not as expensive as we had figured so we saved some money.

FINANCE AND APPROPRIATIONS:

PERMITS AND LICENSE:

Mr. Lingle is here to inquire as to what he can do with his application of liquor license. The Articles of Incorporation should be back in the next couple days. A copy is here. Background check showed there was no reason why he can't do it. There is an issue with the property acquisition but will come up next week. Mr. Diffenderfer made a motion and Mrs. McPhillips seconded to approve issuing a license to Cory's Pub N Grub, Inc. contingent on having everything on the application in compliance. All were in favor. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS:

The water wheel at Paradise Cove ices over. It was thought that the wheel was prepped for the winter, but someone had seen the water wheel moving. Mr. Croup will check with Mr. Marks to see if he did anything.

A motion was made by Mr. Hastings and seconded by Mrs. McPhillips to approve the bills. Roll call was made. All were in favor. Motion carried.
